> RMKS/I. THIS IS A JOINT NETWARCOM - DON CIO MESSAGE. THIS NMCI
> INFORMATION BULLETIN (NIB) PROMULGATES POLICY ON FOREIGN NATIONAL
> USER ACCESS TO NMCI. REF A ESTABLISHES THE USE OF NMCI INFORMATION
> ADVISORIES (NIA) AND NMCI INFORMATION BULLETINS (NIB) TO ADDRESS
> NMCI POLICY AND PROCEDURES.

> 2. THIS NIB APPLIES TO NAVY AND MARINE CORPS USERS.

> 3. THIS BULLETIN ESTABLISHES POLICY FOR FOREIGN NATIONAL (FN) USER
> ACCOUNTS ON THE UNCLASSIFIED NMCI NETWORK AT COMMANDS LOCATED WITHIN
> THE UNITED STATES. THIS POLICY APPLIES ONLY TO USER ACCOUNTS AND
> USER LEVEL PRIVILEGES. IAW REF C, ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS MUST BE
> MET FOR A FN TO HAVE ADMINISTRATOR PRIVILEGES. IN ADDITION, THIS
> BULLETIN APPLIES ONLY TO THE UNCLASSIFIED NETWORK. FN ACCESS TO A
> CLASSIFIED NETWORK OR TO CONTROLLED UNCLASSIFIED INFORMATION ON THE
> UNCLASSIFIED NETWORK REQUIRES ADDITIONAL AUTHORITY DELINEATED WITHIN
> DOD 5200.2-R. THIS POLICY IS DERIVED FROM DOD POLICY OUTLINED IN
> REFS B THROUGH F. THIS POLICY IS INTENDED TO REAFFIRM AND
> CONSOLIDATE EXISTING HIGHER AUTHORITY POLICY AS IT APPLIES TO THE
> NMCI. IF THERE IS A CONFLICT BETWEEN THIS MESSAGE AND REFS B
> THROUGH F, THEN THOSE REFERENCES CONTROL THE POLICY.

> 4. FOREIGN NATIONAL PERSONNEL WHO HAVE BEEN ASSIGNED TO DOD
> ORGANIZATIONS (I.E., FOREIGN LIAISON OFFICERS, FOREIGN EXCHANGE
> PERSONNEL, AND COOPERATIVE PROGRAM PERSONNEL) WILL HAVE THEIR ACCESS
> REQUIREMENTS DEFINED IN THE DELEGATION OF DISCLOSURE AUTHORITY
> LETTER RELATED TO THEIR ASSIGNMENT (REF E REFERS). AS FOR DOD
> FOREIGN NATIONAL EMPLOYEES, FOREIGN NATIONAL SERVICE MEMBERS, AND
> DOD FOREIGN NATIONAL CONTRACTORS, THE DECISION TO AUTHORIZE A USER
> ACCOUNT TO THE NMCI UNCLASSIFIED NETWORK RESTS WITH THE COMMAND
> GRANTING THE ACCESS AND SHOULD BE BASED ON THE FN OFFICIAL DUTIES
> AND NEED FOR ACCESS. FOREIGN NATIONALS GRANTED ACCESS TO THE NMCI
> UNCLASSIFIED NETWORK ARE ELIGIBLE TO BE ISSUED A COMMON ACCESS CARD
> (CAC).

> 5. COMMANDS MAY GRANT FOREIGN NATIONALS NORMAL USER ACCESS TO THE
> UNCLASSIFIED NMCI NETWORK PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING ARE MET.

> A. FN USERS ON THE UNCLASSIFIED NMCI NETWORK MUST HAVE THEIR FN
> AFFILIATION DISPLAYED AS PART OF THEIR EMAIL ADDRESS. NMCI
> INFORMATION BULLETIN TWO BRAVO (NIB-2B) PROVIDES GUIDANCE ON GAL AND
> EMAIL NAMING TO ENSURE FOREIGN NATIONALS ARE CLEARLY IDENTIFIED.
> (REFS B THROUGH D REFER)

> B. AUTO EMAIL SIGNATURE BLOCKS WILL BE USED AND WILL INCLUDE
> FOREIGN INDIVIDUALS NAME, NATIONALITY, DUTY DESCRIPTION, AND
> ORGANIZATION ASSIGNED. FORMAT EXAMPLE: DOE, JOHN WG CDR, UNITED

> KINGDOM-FLO, FLEET COMMANDER, N6 (REF D REFERS). THIS ADDRESS MUST
> BE REFLECTED IN THE FNS CAC EMAIL ADDRESS.
> C. FN WILL NOT BE GRANTED ACCESS TO ENCLAVES PROTECTING CONTROLLED
> UNCLASSIFIED INFORMATION UNLESS ALL INFORMATION CONTAINED ON THE
> ENCLAVE HAS BEEN APPROVED FOR DISCLOSURE TO THAT FOREIGN NATIONALS
> PARENT GOVERNMENT BY AN APPROVED DISCLOSURE AUTHORITY. (REF B AND D
> REFER)
> D. PRIOR TO ACCESS TO NMCI, EACH FN USER WILL SIGN THE USER
> AGREEMENT THAT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING (REF D REFERS):
> (1) ACKNOWLEDGING INFORMATION AND INFORMATION SYSTEM SECURITY
> POLICIES, PROCEDURES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES.
> (2) CONSEQUENCES OF NOT ADHERING TO SECURITY PROCEDURES AND
> RESPONSIBILITIES.
> (3) FOR EMAIL ACCOUNTS, THE USER NAME WILL INCLUDE INDIVIDUALS
> NATIONALITY TO PRECLUDE INADVERTENT DISCLOSURE OF CONTROLLED
> UNCLASSIFIED INFORMATION NOT AUTHORIZED TO FOREIGN NATIONALS.
> E. REMOTE ACCESS AND OUTLOOK WEB ACCESS PRIVILEGES ARE AT THE
> DISCRETION OF THE COMMAND ISSUING THE USER ACCOUNT. IF REMOTE
> ACCESS IS GRANTED, THE DOD PKI SOFTWARE CERTIFICATE ISSUED WILL
> REFLECT THE DIGRAPH "FN" IN THE GENERATIONAL FIELD OF THE
> DISTINGUISHED NAME.
> 5. THIS POLICY DOES NOT REMOVE THE OBLIGATION OF OWNERS OF
> UNCLASSIFIED EXPORT CONTROLLED TECHNICAL DATA FROM ENSURING THAT
> DATA IS SAFEGUARDED IAW THE INTERNATIONAL TRAFFIC IN ARMS
> REGULATIONS (22 CFR 121-128) OR THE EXPORT ADMINISTRATION
> REGULATIONS.
