Subj: PERSONNEL SECURITY POLICY CLARIFICATION
Ref: (a) SECNAVINST 5510.30A

1. The following provides clarification of the guidance in paragraph 9-8 of reference (a) regarding temporary access:

Temporary access may be granted at the highest level of security clearance supportable by a favorably completed investigation. In those cases where a Department of the Navy Central Adjudication Facility (DON CAF) message indicates a favorably completed investigation which would support security clearance eligibility at a higher level, commands may grant temporary access at the higher level, provided an OPNAV Form 5510/413 is submitted to the DON CAF requesting the appropriate clearance adjustment.
